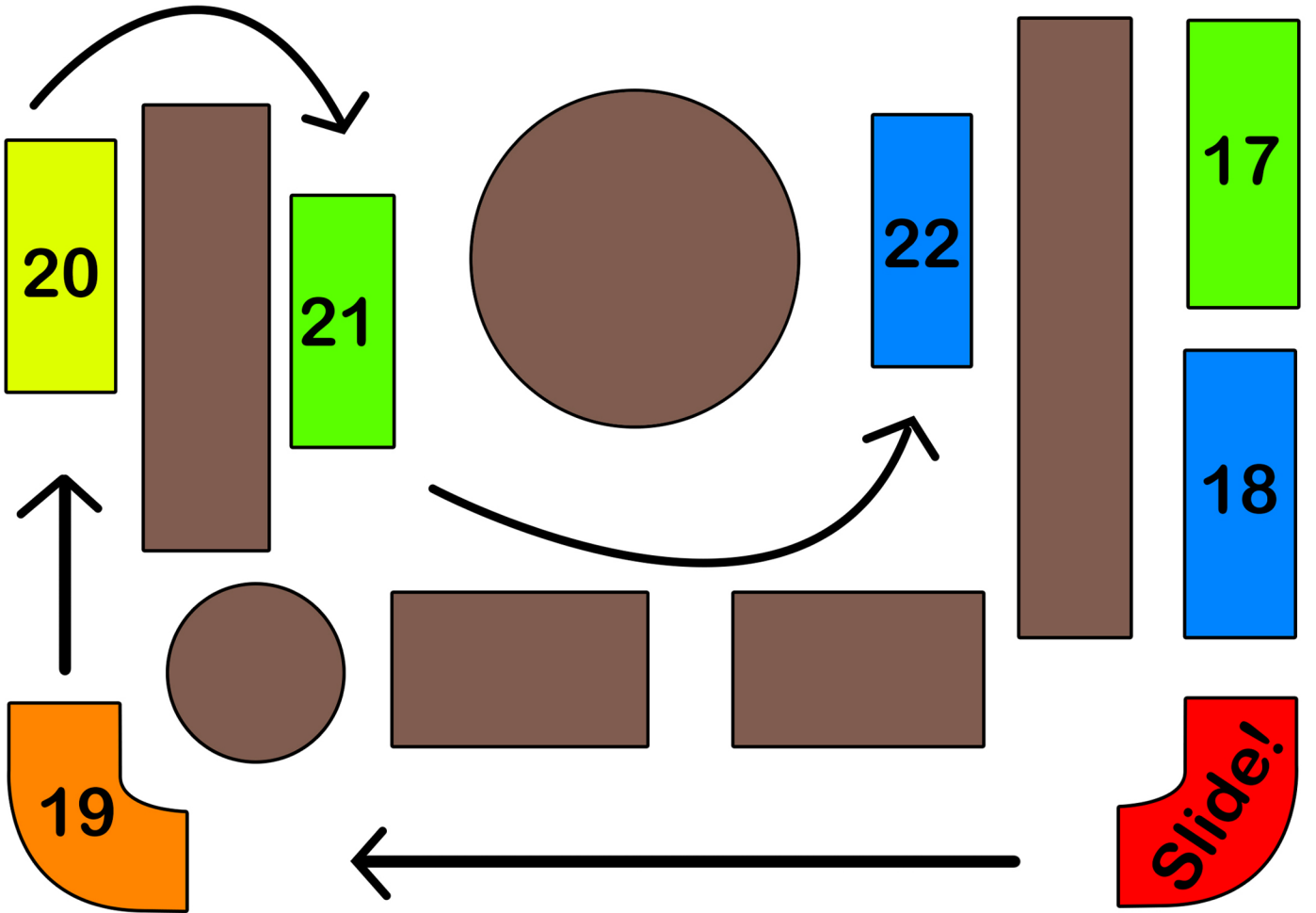
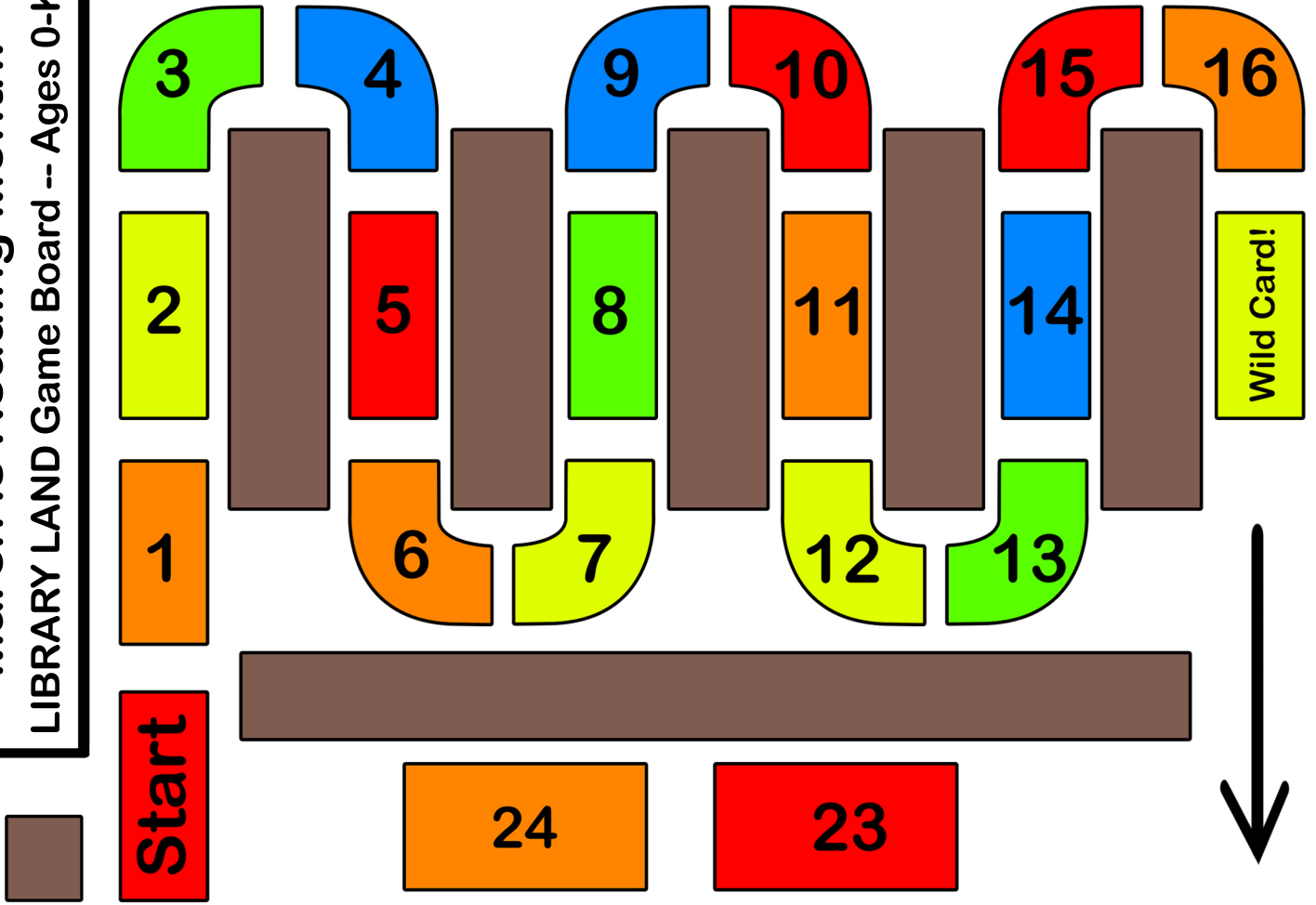


March is Reading Month!

How to Play the At-home game: Grab a penny or a paperclip and pretend you’re visiting the Library! Begin at Start square. Roll a dice, count dots, advance to the numbered space. At each game space, complete game actions, below. Parents may visit the **GLADL website (gladl.org)**, especially our **Early Literacy webpage (gladl.org/earlyliteracy)** or the Kid’s Catalog (gladl.tlcdelivers.com/kids) for some actions, children may describe things to parents. **No Internet access? Parents may swap out a Wild Card Action at any time.** Complete action, mark completed on your card and repeat until you have completed the game. Continue game play until you finish at space #24.

Prizes: Bring your Game Board to the Library and show the staff at the desk to earn an Instant Prize for however much of the Game you have completed. **Finish the Game and each child receives a special Easter Bunny book to keep for their very own!** *One game card per person please. Turn in all Game cards by March 31, 2021.*

2.	Do you like cars? Describe your favorite kind of car!	
3.	Go to the Wild Card spot and do 1 of the actions. Return here to start your next turn.	
4.	On the cover of the book <i>Ramona the Pest</i> , Ramona is running. Can you run in place?	
5.	Do you like to make crafts? Try a FREE Take-Home Crafts for kids from the library!	
6.	Pretend to walk like a dinosaur! Do you like books about dinosaurs?	
7.	Visit our Early Literacy webpage. Do an activity together from the Early Literacy Calendar	
8.	The library has books with horse stories. Pretend you’re riding a horse around the house!	
9.	Go to the Wild Card spot and do 1 of the actions. Return here to start your next turn.	
10.	Pretend you’re taking a trip. Where are you going and what will you do there?	
11.	Pretend to play the guitar or sing a song! Take a bow at the end.	
12.	Name a book you like. (If you visit our Early Literacy webpage, you can click any book on the page to look at it.)	
13.	Find your favorite book. Tell a story about the book’s cover.	
14.	Go to the Wild Card spot and do 1 of the actions. Return here to start your next turn.	
15.	Pretend you’re a mouse. Can you go “squeak-squeak”? The library has many mouse stories.	
16.	Visit our Early Literacy webpage. Complete a Children’s Book Bundle request with your child.	
17.	Can you meow like a cat? Do you have any books about cats?	
18.	Name things that are fun to learn? (Hint --music, colors, numbers, letters and more).	
19.	Look at the picture on our Reading Programs webpage. What animal is sitting in the chair?	
20.	Go to the Wild Card spot and do 1 of the actions. Return here to start your next turn.	
21.	The library has pictures on the wall from some children’s books. Can you draw a picture too?	
22.	The library has many books about birds. Can you flap your arms like a bird?	
23.	Can you tell your parents where you live? (Ex: Michigan, Grand Ledge, in our house , etc.)	
24.	Visit virtual Preschool Story Time our Youtube channel! New stories every week! Follow the link on our homepage to hear wonderful stories and songs.
