
August 2, 2022 Library Millage Request

• On August 2, 2022, the Grand Ledge community will vote on the funding for the Grand Ledge Area District Library for the next 10 years.

• The 1.20 mills ballot request is what the community approved 20 years ago and has been reduced over the years and represents nearly 90% of the Library's annual budget.

• The average homeowner's annual tax bill for the Library will be \$88.32 (roughly about \$60 for every \$100,000 in Market value of your property).

• With this new rate the average homeowner will see in their **tax bill an increase of \$4.31 annually.**
